**Tsunami Relief Fund**

Further to our report tabled at the 33<sup>rd</sup> IPA - IEC meeting held in Dublin in 2005. I have pleasure in reporting that all monies received from the IPA sections World wide through the PEB totaling Sri Lankan Rupees 9,474,880.41 in respect of the above distributed to the affected persons.

Of the monies received directly from IPA German Sections totaling a sum of LKR 730,298.75 a sum of LKR 2,772,747.73 was distributed leaving a balance of LKR 957,551.02 with this balance monies it has been decided to construct a house for the Children of a deceased Police Sergeant who lost his life in the Southern Capital of Sri Lanka namely Galle on the day of Tsunami whilst he was attending to save the lives of Civilians. Plans for the said home to be built on a land in Galle purchased by the widow have been prepared and construction will commence in early October 2006. The Ground Floor of the house is expected to be completed in early May 2007 and is estimated to Cost LKR 700,000/-

We hope to invite a representative or two of the IPA German Section of the "House Warming Ceremony" in May 2007 in the quaint tour of Galle Sri Lanka.

Once again a "Big Thank you" from the IPA Sri Lanka Section to the International President Mr. Michael Odysseos and the IPA World Body for the magnanimous manner in which they responded to our appeal for funds to help the Police Officers and families affected dreaded Tsunami of December 2004.
